# **FR. SEBASTIAN'S REFLECTIONS**

In the first reading (Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48), we see the Apostle Peter entering the home of a "gentile" Cornelius, to bring the message of the Gospel to his household. Peter later met the other disciples and relayed the impact of his visit to the home of a gentile. They were all pleased as Peter later informed them that he baptized them in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The second reading (1 John 4:7-10) reechoes the need for us to love one another. The Apostle John reminds us that our love for God and each other, should transcend every other consideration. It should remain our identity as Christians. We are able to love because God loved us first. Therefore, we cannot keep it to ourselves. It has to be given out to others.

In the Gospel (John 15:9-17) Jesus gives a new commandment to his disciples: "love one another". On our own, it may not be easy, but with God's grace and support, we can spread the word and the love. When we do so, we transcend the level of servants and become "dear friends". This is command from Christ! Love one another! Amen.


